I. Open Meeting called to order at 3:00 pm.

Members present were: Bill Allen, Principal; Karen Jones, Teacher; Brendan O'Keefe, Parent; Karen Jordan, Teacher, and LeAnn Kamer, Parent. Absent: Beth Garrison, Teacher

II. Old Business

- a. Approval of February Minutes. Brendan O'Keefe made a motion to approve the minutes and was seconded by Karen Jones. The motion passed 4-0.

III. New Business

- a. Success Stories. Mrs. Jones and Mrs. Garrison are inviting their students to stay for a voluntary club on Tues. and Thurs. that offers physical exercise and help with school work. So far they have had a good turn out with numerous students in attendance. Dee Lykins will be returning as cheerleading coach. School attendance has improved. The basketball tournament held at LCMS was a success and made money. Mrs. Jones reported that her recent cuneiform tablet project was a successful one.
