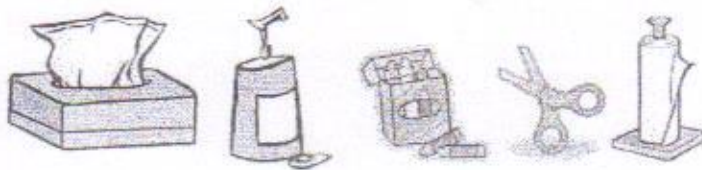

What do I need on the first day of school?

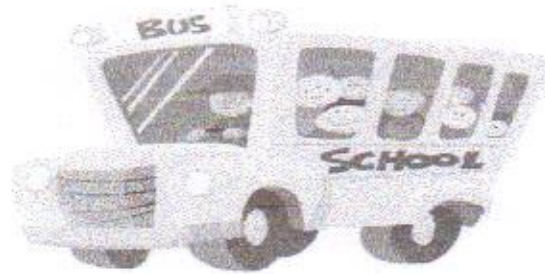
- 3 spiral bound notebooks (wide ruled)

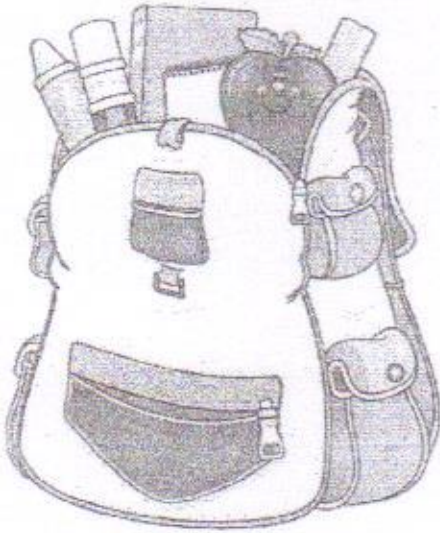
MUST HAVES:

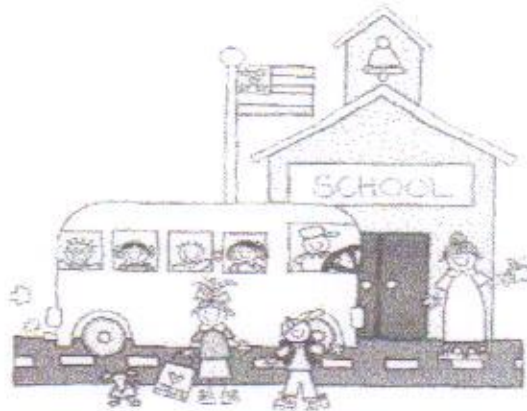
